

Blair County BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS

Affidavit to Appoint a Personal Representative

Blair County does permit taxpayers who wish to appeal their property assessment, but who are unable to attend their scheduled hearing, to have a personal representative attend the hearing on their behalf. PLEASE NOTE that your Authorized Representative must be either a family member or friend who will attend on your behalf <u>without pay</u> or an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania.

Property consultants may not represent taxpayers for a fee at either informal or formal appeals and those who do appear will not be permitted to submit evidence or testify at hearings.

The unauthorized practice of law consists of the procuring of an agreement by one who is not an attorney to institute or prosecute an action in which the compensation shall, directly or indirectly, depend upon the amount of recovery. Section 2525(a) of the Judicial Code, 42 Pa.C.S. § 2525(a).
