

- a. What is the cost of the millings? \$5,056.00. This is currently covered under the HRI contract as a Change Order. The Commissioners may have Park and Rec pay for this.
 - b. What is the cost of transporting the millings? Transportation was included in the fee above.
 - c. What is the cost for a contractor to do the work?
 - i. We received three quotes. New Enterprise Stone and Lime Co. Inc. submitted their information including their insurance and a quote in the amount of \$17,940.00. Cottles Asphalt submitted just a quote in the amount of \$19,240.00. Glenn O. Hawbaker Inc. turned in a late quote of \$19,560.00. Commissioners approved the New Enterprise Stone and Line Co. Inc. quote on March 20, 2025.
 - ii. What is the time line for the contractor to do the work? Surface preparations are to be completed by April 4, 2025. The millings are to be stockpiled by April 18, 2025. New Enterprise to spread the millings and compact by May 2, 2025.
 - iii. While FC814 was made aware on March 27 (when we were informed) that grading was being done on March 27 and 28 in preparation for Millings to be delivered to Valley View on March 31.
 - d. Will Altoona AYSO be able to contribute money designated for the parking lot and if so, how much? Lori Guyer conveyed to FC814 that Altoona AYSO can either include a letter with the donation specifying that the money is to go to the parking lot renovations or the County can provide a Donation Agreement.
3. Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Greenways, Trails, and Recreation Program for 2025- Opens Feb 1 2025 and will close May 31, 2025. (We will need to have this approved by the Board of Commissioners before any preliminary work can be done, due to possibly competing against any grants the County is applying for.)
 4. Department of Natural Resources (DCNR) Grant for 2026 –Will open the second week of January 2026 and will close the first week of April 2026. (We will need to have this submission approved by the Board of Commissioners before any preliminary work can be done, due to possibly competing against any grants the County is applying for.)
 5. GIS would like to have the road that goes through the park named.
 6. Approval of the Valley View Park Summer Playground Program.
