Interchange Lighting – Crosskeys SR 8004:

Larry Bilotto requested approval of a Roadway Lighting Agreement between the County of Blair and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) for Roadway lighting in the Crosskeys section of SR 8004 (US Route 22).

Mr. Bilotto stated that under the new agreement PennDOT will assume the responsibility for the repairs and maintenance of the lights. The county will reimburse PennDOT 50% of the related expenses for the repairs and maintenance.

Mrs. Schmitt stated that the County will assume the responsibility for the electricity expense for the interchange lighting. PennDOT reimburses the county 50% of the fee. The remaining amount is split between the Allegheny Township (60%) and the county (40%).

Discussion followed.
