


Drug Overdose Deaths Among Blair County Residents by Year, 2015-2024*


Blair County Residents' Rate per 10,000 Population of Drug Overdose Deaths by Age Group, 2016-2023*


Blair County Residents' Rate per 10,000 Population of Drug Overdose Deaths by Sex, 2016-2023*

Blair County Residents' Rate per 10,000 Population of Drug Overdose Deaths by Race, 2016-2023*


