## **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Commissioner Erb asked for public comments. No public comments made.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Commissioner Erb provided discussion regarding the averages of wage increases in current union contracts and past increases to non-union employees, including average percentage wage increases due to the Salary Study implementation in July of 2021. He stated that he could support the range of 2.5% to 2.75% increases for elected officials for each of the years 2026-2029.

Commissioner Webster stated elected officials are not in the job for high salaries and that there is an aspect of public service with the job. Her proposed rate increase would be below 2% and she indicated that 1% would be sufficient.

Commissioner Burke stated the union contracts for future years 2023 and 2024 trend between 2.25% and 2.5% and that she would be comfortable with a 2.5% increase each of the four years.

Motion by Commissioner Burke, seconded by Commissioner Erb and approved with a vote 2-1 (Erb – Aye, Burke – Aye, Webster – Nay) to increase all elected official salaries by 2.5% at the start of each calendar year: 2026, 2027, 2028 and 2029.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:13 P.M.
